

Tb Test Result Form

This test is required **annually** for all international students (except those students residing in Canada), for those who have a family member or other close contact that has had tuberculosis, and for students who have spent greater than 4 weeks in a country with high prevalence of tuberculosis. BCG vaccination does not preclude testing a student.

Please note that IGRA (Interferon-Gamma Release Assays) are the preferred method of testing for: Persons who have received BCG vaccination

Induration of **5 mm** is considered positive in (HIV)-infected persons, recent contacts of TB case patients

Induration of **10 mm** is considered positive in recent immigrants (i.e., within the last 5 years) from countries with a high prevalence of TB, persons with the following clinical conditions that place them at high risk: - silicosis - diabetes mellitus - chronic renal failure - some hematologic disorders (e.g., leukemias and lymphomas) - other specific malignancies (e.g., carcinoma of the head, neck, or lung) - Infants, children, and adolescents exposed to adults at high risk for developing active TB

Induration of **15 mm** is considered positive in persons with no known risk factors for TB
